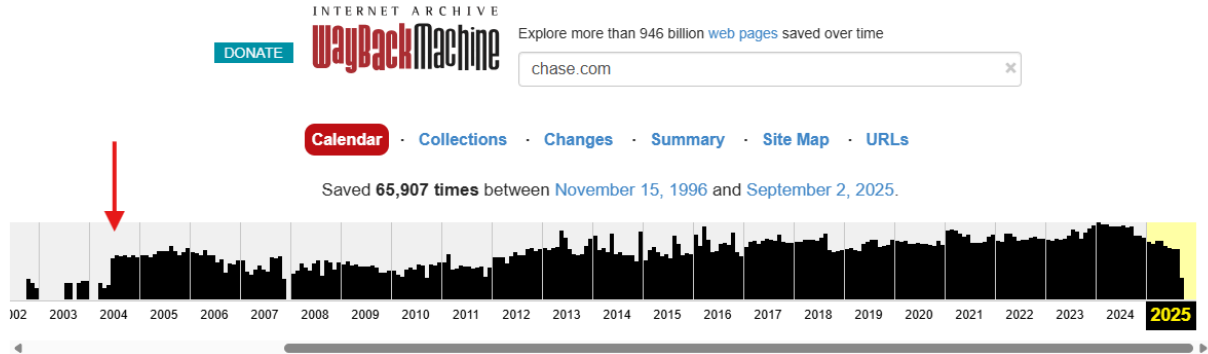


Go to archive.org.

Enter the website you are looking for, select "Search archived web sites," and click on Go. Here we are looking for "chase.com".

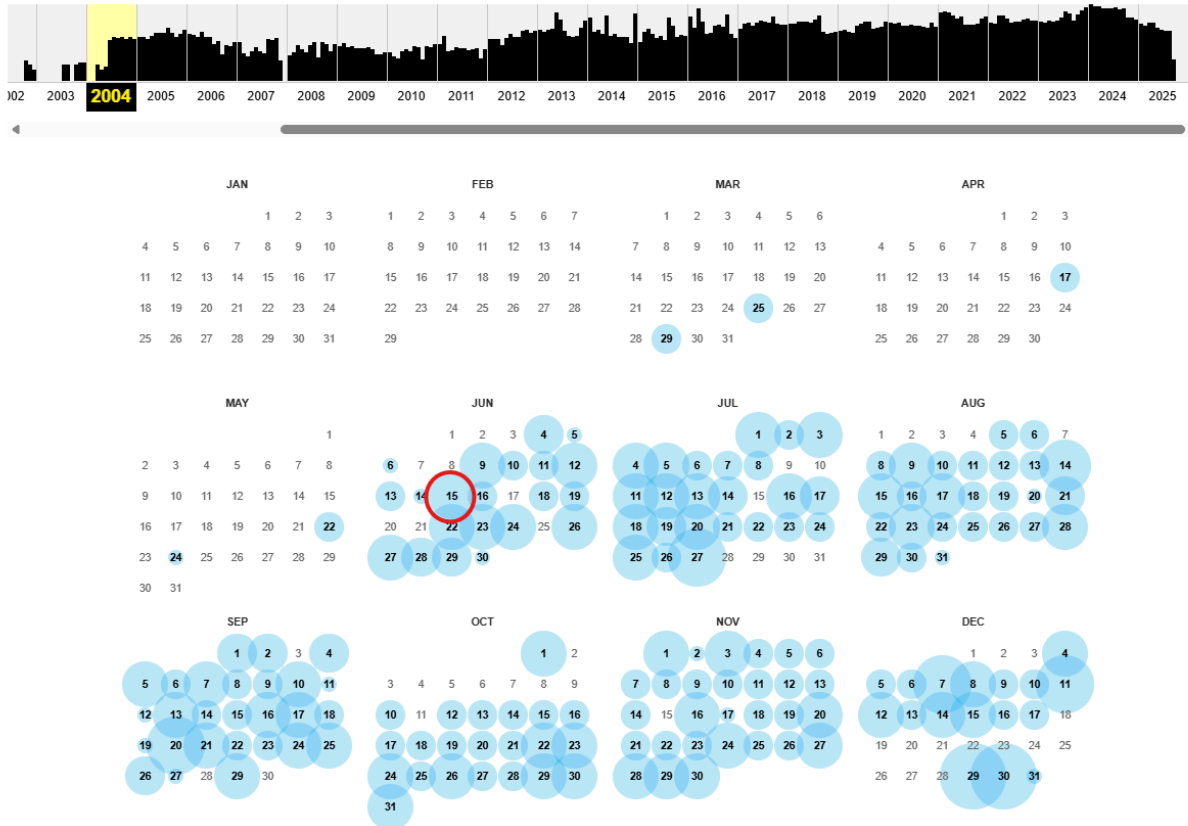


If you are looking for something from 2004, click on that pane:



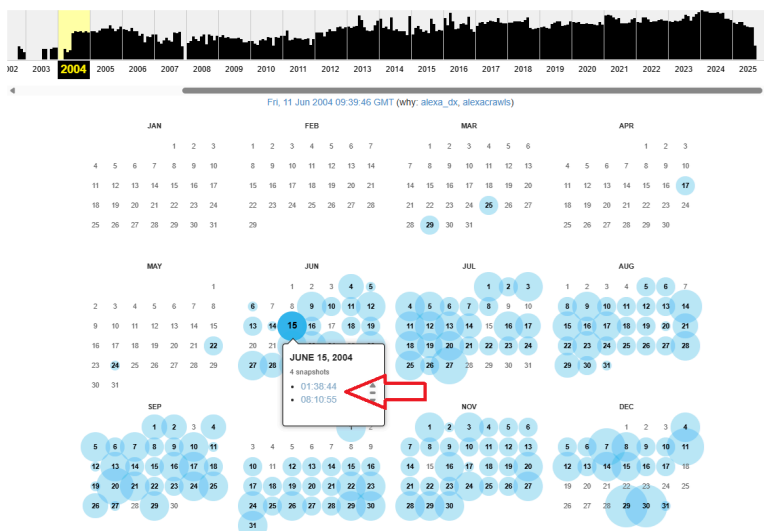
Select the date from 2004 that you want. Here we will look at June 15. Click on June 15.

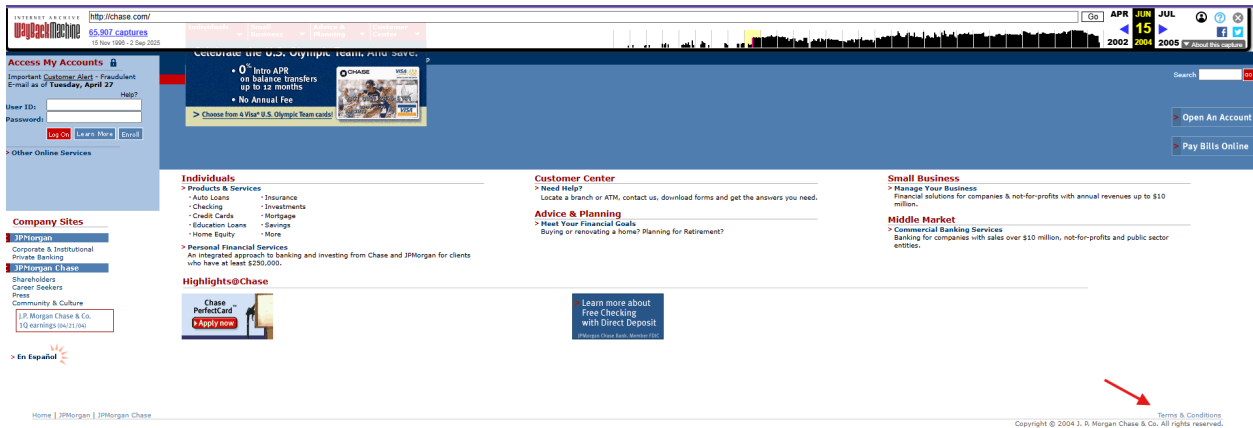


Select one of the snapshots:

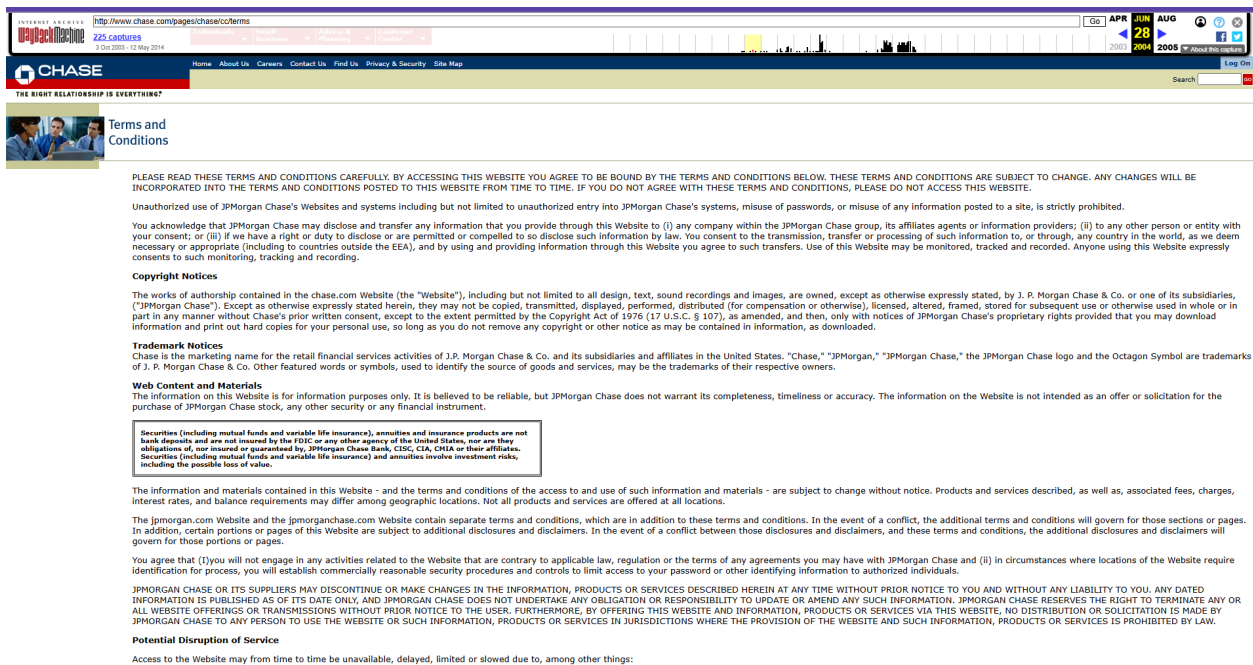


You will then be directed to the archived website. Locate the link for "Terms and Conditions" and click on it.



That should take you where you want to go.

A couple of caveats,

- It really helps to know the website name you are looking for. Sometimes businesses change their domain names. For example, chase.com may once have been jpmorganchase.com or something similar.
- You may need to try a couple of different snapshots or a couple of different days, as sometimes not everything on a result page is archived.
- The blue bubbles on the calendar are actual archives. The green bubbles are re-directs and sometimes they do not produce any results. The orange bubbles indicate that the url was not found. See second image above.
